Stoke) it is recorded, <sup>under 1857 A.D.</sup> that the broken tombstone of a "Mr Spooner", "a Benefactor of the Poor", which had been used to cover a fuel store placed against the church, had been repaired & replaced on its frame. <sup>Possibly</sup> This was the broken stone no 26 though the Spooner who founded a charity was not a John Spooner, but a Henry Spooner who died in 1618. (See no 34 on p. 18 above).

\* { 26. ? "Mr John Spooner of Burchet" — <sup>1735</sup> bur. 16 Aug 1735 — 10 March 1720 " is probably the entry in the Parish Register that corresponds. Bax has "departed this life March ye 7 1794". His month and day agree with the above Register entry but his 1794 is almost certainly wrong as there is no burial of a John Spooner registered after 1735 (whereas "Mr John Spooner of Burchet" is entered as "buried 16 August 1735"). There is an entry of a Mr John Spooner buried 3 July 1712, but the day & month not fitting either in the 1735 or the 1712 entry, the 1720 entry has the preference.
